WHO: BACHELOR AND MASTER STUDENTS FROM ALL UNIVERSITIES

attending (part of) the conference.

before midnight (24:00 hours) on 3 July. The jury – consisting of UvA and The Broker staff members – will announce the winner and runner-up and publish their blogs as 'expert opinions' on The Broker website in the week of 4 July.
